

OSHA Standard Construction 29 CFR Part 1926

2. All safety and training education is the responsibility of the employer except for: **CPR Certification** [1926.21 \(all of section b\)](#)
3. Who is responsible for providing safety training for employees? **The employer** [1926.21\(b\)\(2\)](#)
4. Confined or enclosed space is defined as **any space having limited means of egress, which is subject to the accumulation of toxic or flammable contaminants or has an oxygen deficit atmosphere** [1926.21 \(6\) \(ii\)](#)
5. Who is responsible for providing first aid services and provisions for medical care for employees? **The employer** [1926.23](#)
6. Containers used for storing flammable waste shall be equipped with: **Covers** [1926.25\(c\)](#)
7. The contents of the first aid kit shall be placed in a weatherproof container with individually sealed packages for each type of item and shall be checked by the employer at least?
